5.1 CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO RECOMMEND TRAFFIC REDUCTION MEASURES FOR HOLBROOK LANE

M/S McKeithen/Rugeiro to accept staff recommendations to change timing on the signal lights at Marsh and Middlefield, and to study changes in traffic patterns and volume of cars on Holbrook. Do another traffic count after timing changes. Report back at the April 2007 meeting. Contractor Republic Electric - Maximum budget \$15,000. Motion carried.

1. Increase green time on Marsh between 7-9 am
2. Signalize the right turn lane on w/b Marsh with green arrow that coincides with s/b left turn from Middlefield
3. Signalize the right turn lane on n/b Middlefield with green arrow that coincides with the w/b left turn from Marsh
4. Place warning or advisory signs on Marsh Road at Fair Oaks Avenue
“Caution, Stopped Traffic Ahead”
