

5.0 AGENDA ITEMS:

5.1 DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO INSTALL "SCHOOL ZONE" SIGNS ON PARK LANE, NEAR ELENA – Tina Goldman – carryover July 12/Oct 11, 2005

Officer Kockler reported that the radar trailer was set up and a study done at this intersection. Average speed 24.1 mph and 85th percentile speed was 31 mph.

Recommendation/Action Taken: Public Works to install two yellow "rocker" signs on the speed limit signs in each directions stating "School Zone." Chief Brennan to advise Tina Goldman of committee's action.

5.2 DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT ON VALPARAISO AVENUE FROM 35 MPH TO 30 MPH

Recommendation/Action Taken: M/S McKeithen/Ruggerio that the Town lower the speed limit on Valparaiso from 35 mph to 30 mph if Menlo Park agrees. To also add a "school" rocker arm to the speed limit signs. Motion carried.

5.3 DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO RECOMMEND A TRIAL AGREEMENT FOR RED LIGHT VIOLATION CAMERAS

Chief Brennan recommended that the cameras be installed at Marsh/Middlefield, Oak Grove/Middlefield, and ECR/Atherton Avenue. The estimated cost for setup and study results \$500/per light. Potential revenue - \$150 per violation.

Councilmember McKeithen asked that staff do further research of other companies, costs, installation, termination clauses and drop-off rate of violations and report back to the City Council.

Recommendation/Action Taken: M/S Poponis/McKeithen Staff to prepare a summary/comparison of different systems and costs, and to report back to the February or March City Council meeting. Motion Carried.

6.2 Public Works Department - PW Director Jones reported on the following:

- a. Caltrain Corridor Committee requested signs stating "Trains do not Stop– Monday thru Friday" be put up at the Fair Oaks and Watkins grade crossings.

- b. Traffic Signal at Selby and ECR - Caltrans advised staff that this intersection meets the signal warrants three different ways, but they do not have funds. If anyone interested in putting one in, just apply for an encroachment permit. Est. cost \$350,000. PW to contact Selby HOA and/or the County if interested.
- c. New Pavement Condition Study complete. Finance in process of reviewing Road Impact fees.
- d. Valparaiso/Victoria Manor Barriers – staff met with Menlo Park to consider removing the barricades since Blockbuster is now closed. Staff to contact Victoria HOA.
- e. Emily Avenue/Valparaiso – re-stripe intersection and create left turn pocket. Staff to get feedback from residents
