5.1 Status of Bike | Pedestrian Draft Master Plan – Presented by Casey Hildreth, Alta Planning

 - El Camino Real – reduction of lanes and/or reduction of lane widths.

5.2 Sandy Lee – Discussion on bicycle safety on Middlefield and Linden

- A discussion took place between Sandy Lee and members of the Transportation Committee, Police Department, Gordon Siebert, and members of the community who were present at the meeting.
- Gordon Siebert will look into the situation to try and come up with ideas to make the intersection safer for bicyclists.

6.1 OLD BUSINESS: (STATUS OF)

- a. Stop light – Selby/El Camino Real – G. Siebert
 - There is currently no action being taken on this item.
- b. Alameda/Stockbridge – Status – G. Siebert

- There are no complaints with the flashing light.
- The shrubbery has been cut back, which is causing extra vehicle noise for residents.
- The painting is still to come.

- c. Hybrid Beacon – G. Siebert
 - CalTrans may be willing to install the Hybrid Beacon at a location other than the intersection of El Camino Real and Selby Lane.
- d. Alameda/Atherton Avenue Roundabout proposal – G. Siebert
 - The roundabout failed at the Atherton City Council Meeting by a 2-2 vote.
- e. Encinal School parking
 - The Town of Atherton is working with Encinal School to solve the traffic issues.
 - There is currently no money available to widen Middlefield Road.
