RE: TRAFFIC REPORT – February 2022

The following is a summary of the activities that have occurred during the month, as well as a summary of the collision, citation and DUI statistics for the Police Department.

TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS

The Atherton Police Department received No traffic complaints from residents during the month of February.

MONTHLY DUI REPORT

Seven (7) arrest was made for Driving Under the Influence during the month of February. None of these arrests were the result of a traffic collision.

TRUCK ENFORCEMENT DATA

No Truck Stop Details were performed during the month of February.

TRAFFIC OFFICER SCHEDULE

Sergeant Metzger, Officer Rojas, Officer MacDonald and Reserve Officer Boyle were assigned to the Traffic Division during the month of February. These officers utilized

their police motorcycles and worked traffic enforcement as time and calls for service permitted.

Sergeant Metzger was scheduled for 168 hours and produced 66 combined cites.
Officer Rojas was Scheduled for FMLA this period and produced no citations.
Officer MacDonald was scheduled for 144 hours and produced 87 combined cites.
Reserve Officer Boyle was scheduled for 96 hours and produced 13 combined cites.

On Saturday, 02/19/2022, Sergeant Metzger and Officer MacDonald conducted directed enforcement for bicyclist. As a result of the morning enforcement, a total of 8 cyclist were contacted.

TRAFFIC COLLISION DATA

During the month of February, a total of four (4) traffic collisions occurred in the Town of Atherton. Two (2) of the collisions involved injuries. One (1) of the collisions involved a Hit-and-Run. None of the collisions involved a driver who was driving under the influence.

The collisions occurred in the following locations:

- 1) The intersection of Alameda De Las Pulgas and Mardarin Av. (Injury)
Thursday, 8:11am, three vehicle collision
All three vehicles traveling southbound Alameda De Las Pulgas
Injuries: Complaint of Pain
- 2) In front of 76 Ridgeview (Non-injury)
Wednesday, 9:43am, Unsafe Backing
Vehicle #1: Backing out of driveway of 76 Ridgeview
Vehicle #2: parked along the north shoulder of Ridgeview
- 3) The Intersection of El Camino Real and Maple Av (Non- injury)
Friday, 4:18pm, Unsafe Speed.
Vehicle #1: Northbound El Camino Real
Vehicle #2: Northbound El Camino Real
Vehicle #3: Northbound El Camino Real
- 4) In front of 555 Middlefield Rd. (Injury)
Tuesday, 9:32pm, Unsafe Turning Movement
Vehicle #1: Swerved off Middlefield Road and collided with tree
Injuries: Complaint of pain

Of the above collisions, two (2) occurred during the morning commute period, 6:00am to 10:00am, Monday through Friday.

Of the above collisions, one (1) occurred during the afternoon commute period, 3:00pm to 7:00pm, Monday through Friday.
