RE: TRAFFIC REPORT – FEBRUARY 2014

The following is a summary of the activities that have occurred during the month, as well as a summary of the collision, citation and DUI statistics for the Police Department.

TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS

The Atherton Police Department received two (2) traffic complaints during the month of February. The complaints were as follows:

- 1) Steven Napoli, 154 Catalpa Drive, reported speeding vehicles in the 100 block of Catalpa Drive during the morning and afternoon commute hours.

Morning Commute Results: 58 minutes spent in the area
