RE: TRAFFIC REPORT – JANUARY 2014

The following is a summary of the activities that have occurred during the month, as well as a summary of the collision, citation and DUI statistics for the Police Department.

### **TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS**

The Atherton Police Department received three (3) traffic complaints during the month of January. The complaints were as follows:

- 1) Anonymous caller reported a motorcycle driving recklessly on eastbound Stockbridge Avenue at approximately 8:15am.  
  
Results: 31 minutes spent in the area  
No violations were observed
- 2) Richard Bradshaw, 55 Rosewood Drive, reported speeding vehicles on Oak Grove Avenue, between Greenoaks Drive and Middlefield Road, from 7:30am to 8:30am on Monday through Friday.  
  
Results: 84 minutes spent in the area  
2 citations issued, 2 warning citations issued
- 3) Debbie Martinez, 150 Valparaiso Avenue, reported vehicles not stopping at the flashing crosswalk lights, and vehicles driving in the bike lane, from 7:30am to 8:00am on Monday through Friday

2 citations issued, 1 unknown disposition

### **MONTHLY DUI REPORT**

Three (3) arrests were made for Driving Under the Influence during the month of January. None of these arrests were the result of a traffic collision.

### **TRAFFIC COLLISION DATA**

During the month of January, a total of eleven (11) traffic collisions occurred in the Town of Atherton. Five (5) collisions involved injuries. Four (4) collisions were hit-and-runs. No collisions were caused by drivers who were driving under the influence.

- 9) Middlefield Road, 30' north of Marsh Road (Injury)  
Friday, 8:50am, Speeding, Rear-End

10) El Camino Real, 135' south of Almedral Avenue (Hit and Run)  
Saturday, Unknown Time, Unsafe Turning, Hit Object

11) The intersection of El Camino Real and Walnut Avenue (Injury)
