REGULAR STAFF

For the month of February (as of 2/24/2015)

Inspect Irrigation System- 25.0hrs Inspect and remove/replace systems in the project areas in park

Tree/Brush Cutting- 10.5hrs Trimming trees impeding pathway and suckers along train tracks

Storm patrol- 9.0hrs Controlling flooding and cleanup from storm

Replace Shrubs- 8.0hrs Putting in plants in project areas

Other Irrigation-8.0hrs Goes along with inspect irrigation above

Other Beautification- 6.5hrs Spread wood chips

In house Pruning- 5.5hrs Goes along with tree/brush cutting above

Irrigation Line Repair- 4.0hrs Goes along with inspect irrigation repair

Building Misc. Maintenance- 1.5hrs Repair tables in main house

Playcourt Maintenance- 1.0hrs Remove pine needles on tennis courts

Building Maintenance- 1.0hrs reprogram all thermostats and check lights

Tree Staking- 1.0hrs Replace broken stakes on trees

Drinking fountain Maintenance- 0.5hr Unclog drinking fountain

This month involved a lot of cleanup in the park. The short storm we had knocked the majority of leaves and dead branches out of the trees. The trees behind the baseball field (3rd base side) were trimmed up and away from the pathway. Much of the irrigation system was upgraded and replaced in our three project areas. The project areas by the water tower (#16) and the daffodil garden (#5) just received a combined 120 new plants. This completed the project around the water tower. The project in the daffodil garden is near complete just waiting for the installation of a new decomposed granite pathway. The bridge project (#3) is currently getting the final preparations from the sod that will be laid any minute now. This will give us a nice green area rather than the dead brown area that has existed for a few years now. The tables in the main house received some love and any issues with them has been fix as bent screws that kept them

from being folded were replaced. The carpets in the Pavilion are currently being cleaned and will look fresh and be ready to go by tomorrow.
