SUBJECT: PARK GOINGS ON JUNE 2015

REGULAR STAFF

For the month of June (as of 06/28/2015)

- Inspect Irrigation System- Inspect and remove/replace systems in the project areas in park.
- Tree/Brush Cutting- trimming trees impeding pathway and suckers all around property.
- Other Irrigation-goes along with inspect irrigation above.
- In house pruning- goes along with tree/brush cutting above.
- Irrigation Line Repair, valve replacement, wire tracing and troubleshooting- Goes along with inspect irrigation repair.
- Building Misc. Maintenance – maintain and supply restrooms as need.
- Play court Maintenance- Remove pine needles, weeds and trash bags on tennis courts.
- Tree Staking- Replace broken stakes on trees.
- Drinking fountain Maintenance- Unclog and clean as required drinking fountain structures.
- 2 “Pines” and 4 “Elm” dead trees got removed by arborist/tree company throughout the property.
- “Monkey Puzzle” trees got serviced by arborist/tree company to get the “Bunya Pine Nuts” removed.
- Spot spray to control undesirable weeds throughout the property.
- Well pump compressor got replaced and sand separators/water filters got serviced by water well tech specialist.
- Irrigation master valve got rebuilt and all system flushed accordingly.
- Playground structures are being maintained and repaired as required once a week.
- “Main House” elevator was inspected and serviced this month by tech specialist per 2 times a year service requirement.
- Little League outfield fence and left field foul pole removed and stored 7/1/2015.

This month a noticeable amount of irrigation improvements have been completed. From well maintenance, repair and improvements to unground field wire, valve rebuilds and replacement, fixed water leaks, reprogramming of two wire controller, replaced malfunctioning and broken sprinklers. All these improvements have been done having in consideration water savings and water efficient application. Dead trees and plants are being removed to avoid safety liability and spreading of diseases throughout the park, as well these are being pruned considering safety and appearance, giving them a natural look. Play court has been maintained and kept up to standards and structural improvements are being schedule. Buildings and structures are regularly checked, inspected for electrical, plumbing and any safety hazards.
