SUBJECT: PARK GOINGS ON FEBRUARY 2016

REGULAR STAFF

For the month of FEBRUARY, 2016:

- Blow and removal of tree leaves and debris trough out property.
- Spread wood chips along and between Jennings Pavilion and Tennis Courts.
- Weed control throughout the property and planter areas.
- Applied triple 15 (15-15-15) fertilizer to trees and plants based on requirements.
- Fertilize turf and rose bushes at Gilmore House.
- Still spreading wood-chip at North Meadow planter areas.
- Turf irrigation systems back on in all park with minimum water application based on weather conditions.
- Landscape irrigation inspections, tuning and repair will be performed as water comes back on line.
- City water POC/Back Flow devices have been installed and will get a concrete slab to secure a metal cage.
- Little League field has been reopened and the outfield fence, left field foul pole and left field foul fence have been reinstalled.
- All fire extinguishers refilled and inspected with accordance of Fire Marshall Requirements per sub-contractor.
- Turf renovation (phase I) is in process to be completed by 03/03.

HAPPENINGS

The Roses received their annual pruning as well as an oil and winter fertilizer application. The Event Garden has fallen behind of its planned schedule mainly due to the stormy weather we have been blessed with the past month. With the latest streak of good weather, the garden could be opened up as early as March 4th.
