**SUBJECT: REVIEW AND DISCUSS THE ISSUANCE OF A LETTER TO THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGARDING OPERATIONS AT SAN CARLOS AIRPORT; AND, IF APPROPRIATE, AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A LETTER ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN**

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Review and discuss the issuance of a letter to the County of San Mateo Board of Supervisors regarding operations at San Carlos Airport; and, if appropriate, authorize the Mayor to execute a letter on behalf of the Town.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Aircraft Noise Subcommittee (Lewis/Lempres) met with interested parties regarding operations at San Carlos Airport related to the operation of Surf Air. The Subcommittee is recommending that the Town consider sending a letter to the County Board of Supervisors outlining the Town's continued concerns.

#### **POLICY FOCUS**

The City Council has been engaged on this issue for several years and has adopted a policy to support a remedy that reducing aircraft noise and hazard over the Town of Atherton. The proposed correspondence would focus policy attention on the County Board of Supervisors to take some action regarding the Town's concerns.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

Public notification was achieved by posting the agenda, with this agenda item being listed, at least 72 hours prior to the meeting in print and electronically. Information about the committee and commission vacancies was also disseminated via the Town's electronic News Flash and Atherton Online between March and June. There are approximately 1,300 subscribers to the Town's electronic News Flash publications. Subscribers include residents as well as stakeholders – to include, but be not limited to, media outlets, school districts, Menlo Park Fire District, service providers (water, power, and sewer), and regional elected officials.
