RE: TRAFFIC REPORT – JULY 2013

The following is a summary of the activities that have occurred during the month, as well as a summary of the collision, citation and DUI statistics for the Police Department.

TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS

The Atherton Police Department received two (2) traffic complaints during the month of July. The traffic complaints were as follows:

- 1) Francis Hunter, 2969 Woodside Road, reported speeding construction trucks on El Camino Real from 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday. The reporting party requested more traffic control on El Camino Real throughout the day.

MONTHLY DUI REPORT

Two (2) arrests were made for Driving Under the Influence during the month of July. Neither of these arrests were the result of a traffic collision.

TRUCK ENFORCEMENT DATA

TRAFFIC OFFICER SCHEDULE

For the month of July, Traffic Officer Marks worked a combined 94 hours out of 175 scheduled hours on traffic enforcement, traffic program administrative tasks, and patrol shift coverage.

TRAFFIC COLLISION DATA

During the month of July, a total of eight (8) traffic collisions occurred in the Town of Atherton. Four (4) collisions involved injuries. One (1) collision was a hit-and-run. No collisions were caused by a driver who was driving under the influence.

The collisions occurred in the following locations:

- 1) Fair Oaks Lane, 50' east of El Camino Real
- 2) El Camino Real, 6' south of Selby Lane (Hit and Run)
- 3) The property of 1 Tuscaloosa Avenue
- 4) El Camino Real, 15' north of 5th Avenue (Injury)
- 5) Marsh Road, .25 miles east of Middlefield Road
- 6) The intersection of Valparaiso Avenue and University Drive (Injury)
- 7) The intersection of Glenwood Avenue and Laurel Avenue (Injury)
- 8) El Camino Real, 102' north of Ashfield Road (Injury)
