RE: TRAFFIC REPORT – AUGUST 2013

The following is a summary of the activities that have occurred during the month, as well as a summary of the collision, citation and DUI statistics for the Police Department.

TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS

The Atherton Police Department received two (2) traffic complaints during the month of August. The traffic complaints were as follows:

1) Connie Gay, 440 Walsh Road, reported speeding vehicles on Walsh Road between the hours of 7:00am and 10:00am, and again between the hours of 3:00pm and 6:00pm.

Results: 96 minutes spent in the area

2) Christos Koliass, 1 Watkins Avenue, reported speeding dump trucks on El Camino Real during the night.

MONTHLY DUI REPORT

Three (3) arrests were made for Driving Under the Influence during the month of August. None of these arrests were the result of a traffic collision.

TRAFFIC OFFICER SCHEDULE

For the month of August, Traffic Officer Marks worked a combined 136 hours out of 188 scheduled hours on traffic enforcement, traffic program administrative tasks, and patrol shift coverage.

TRAFFIC COLLISION DATA

During the month of August, a total of twelve (12) traffic collisions occurred in the Town of Atherton. Five (5) collisions involved injuries. One (1) collision was a hit-and-run. No collisions were caused by a driver who was driving under the influence.

- 5) Marsh Road, 450' east of Middlefield Road (Injury)
- 6) The intersection of Valparaiso Avenue and Hoover Street
- 7) The intersection of El Camino Real and Stockbridge Avenue
- 8) The intersection of Watkins Avenue and Middlefield Road
- 9) El Camino Real, 37' north of Selby Lane
- 10) Valparaiso Avenue, 36' east of San Mateo Drive
- 11) Middlefield Road, 30' south of Oak Grove Avenue (Injury, Hit and Run)
- 12) The property of 230 Valparaiso Avenue (Injury)
