NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT AND SCOPING MEETING FOR THE MENLO SCHOOL AND MENLO COLLEGE CARTAN FIELD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Atherton will be the Lead Agency and will prepare an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the project described below. The Town will conduct a public scoping meeting for the purpose of soliciting oral and written comments from interested parties, responsible agencies, agencies with jurisdiction by law, trustee agencies, and involved federal agencies, as to the appropriate scope and content of the EIR for the Cartan Field Upgrade Project.

All interested parties are invited to attend a public scoping meeting to assist in identifying issues to be addressed in the EIR. Attendees will have an opportunity to provide input to the consultants preparing the EIR. The public scoping meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 9, 2013 starting at 6:00 p.m. at the Atherton City Council Chambers, 94 Ashfield Road, Atherton, CA 94027.

Description: Menlo College and Menlo School jointly are proposing to completely reconstruct the Cartan Field sports facility. Cartan Field is located at the northwest corner of El Camino Real and Alejandra Avenue. All of the existing uses and fields will be completely demolished and rebuilt with state-of-the-art designs. Also, four additional tennis courts for a total a ten courts, a new aquatics center and 103 additional parking spaces for a total of 168 spaces will be included. This Project represents upgrading of sports facilities only and is not connected with any increase in enrollment at the schools. There are few changes to the overall Menlo College and Menlo School sporting activities, however, some activities will move from the main campuses to Cartan Field, as detailed in the Initial Study.
