RE: TRAFFIC REPORT – SEPTEMBER 2013

The following is a summary of the activities that have occurred during the month, as well as a summary of the collision, citation and DUI statistics for the Police Department.

TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS

The Atherton Police Department received one (1) traffic complaint during the month of September. The traffic complaint was as follows:

- 1) Virginia Stache, 44 Edge Road, reported a speeding motorcyclist on southbound Edge Road towards Ringwood Avenue at 1700 hours.

MONTHLY DUI REPORT

One (1) arrest was made for Driving Under the Influence during the month of September. This arrest was not the result of a traffic collision.

TRUCK ENFORCEMENT DATA

No truck stop details were performed during the month of September.

TRAFFIC OFFICER SCHEDULE

For the month of September, Traffic Officer Marks worked a combined 157 hours out of 192 scheduled hours on traffic enforcement, traffic program administrative tasks, and patrol shift coverage.

TRAFFIC COLLISION DATA

During the month of September, a total of sixteen (16) traffic collisions occurred in the Town of Atherton. Two (2) collisions involved fatalities. Five (5) collisions involved injuries. Three (3) collisions were hit-and-runs. No collisions were caused by a driver who was driving under the influence.

The collisions occurred in the following locations:

- 1) Fletcher Drive, 200' west of Alta Vista (Hit and Run)
- 2) James Avenue, 6' east of Middlefield Road
- 3) Middlefield Road, 153' north of Ravenswood Avenue
- 4) The intersection of Middlefield Road and San Benito Avenue
- 5) The intersection of El Camino Real and Watkins Avenue (Injury)
- 6) Middlefield Road, 60' south of Marsh Road (Injury)
- 7) The intersection of Valparaiso Avenue and Emilie Avenue (Injury)
- 8) The intersection of Valparaiso Avenue and Atherton Oaks
- 9) The intersection of Middlefield Road and Fair Oaks Lane (Injury)
- 10) Middlefield Road, 275' north of Ringwood Avenue
- 11) Fletcher Drive Cul-De-Sac, 300' south of Fletcher Drive
- 12) The intersection of El Camino Real and Valparaiso Avenue (Injury)
- 13) El Camino Real, 200' north of Selby Lane
- 14) Middlefield Road, 180' south of Surrey Lane (Fatal, Hit and Run)
- 15) The intersection of El Camino Real and Selby Lane (Fatal)
- 16) Middlefield Road, 50' south of Encinal Avenue (Hit and Run)
