IN RECOGNITION OF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER APPRECIATION WEEK

WHEREAS, the State of California has proclaimed the 2nd week of October as Code Enforcement Officer Appreciation Week; and

WHEREAS, the Code Enforcement Officer provides for the safety, health, and welfare of citizens within the Town of Atherton through the enforcement of local, state, and federal laws and ordinances dealing with various issues of building, zoning, housing, animal control, environmental, health, and life safety; and

WHEREAS, the Code Enforcement Officer has a challenging and demanding role and often does not receive recognition for the job done to improve the quality of life for residents; and

WHEREAS, the role of the Code Enforcement Officer has expanded in recent years with jurisdictions increasingly relying on the expertise and training of Code Enforcement Officers in their communities; and

WHEREAS, the Code Enforcement Officer is a dedicated, highly qualified, and highly trained professional who share the goals of preventing neighborhood deterioration, enhancing communities, ensuring safety, and preserving property values through knowledge, training, and application of housing, zoning, and nuisance laws; and

WHEREAS, the Code Enforcement Officer often has a highly visible role, particularly in the Town of Atherton and regularly interacts with the public and a variety of federal, state, county, and local officials in their capacity as a code enforcement officer; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Atherton wants to recognize and honor the Code Enforcement Officer that serves our community and acknowledge their role in leading the way to improve quality of life within our community.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that City Council of the Town of Atherton hereby proclaims the second week of October in 2019, and annually thereafter, be known as Code Enforcement Officer Appreciation Week in the Town of Atherton; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council calls upon Atherton residents to join in recognizing and expressing their appreciation for the dedication and service by Monica Diaz who serves as our Code Enforcement Officer.
