**SUBJECT: SAN MATEO COUNTY ELECTIONS DIVISION VOTING SYSTEM
DEMONSTRATION**

RECOMMENDATION

Receive a presentation from the San Mateo County Elections Division regarding the County's newly acquired Democracy Suites 5.2 Voting System.

BACKGROUND

The San Mateo County Elections Division issued a Request for Information to which they received three (3) responses. The responses were from Dominion Voting Systems, Hart InterCivic and Elections Systems & Software. Each vendor was required to undergo rigorous testing at the State level before being verified as a certified vendor within California by the Secretary of State. The San Mateo County Elections Division ultimately chose the Dominion Voting System and will deploy the system in the November 5, 2019 Election.

There is no formal action associated with this item. It is informational only.

In light of the State of California's shift to a Voting Center Model as a result of Senate Bill No. 450, it is important for jurisdictions making the transition to educate voters. Although Atherton will not have an election in November 2019, these systems will be deployed in other communities and there will be a Primary and General Election in 2020. The Town will be evaluating collaborative methods to continue to educate Atherton Voters on any changes that have an impact to their voting experience.

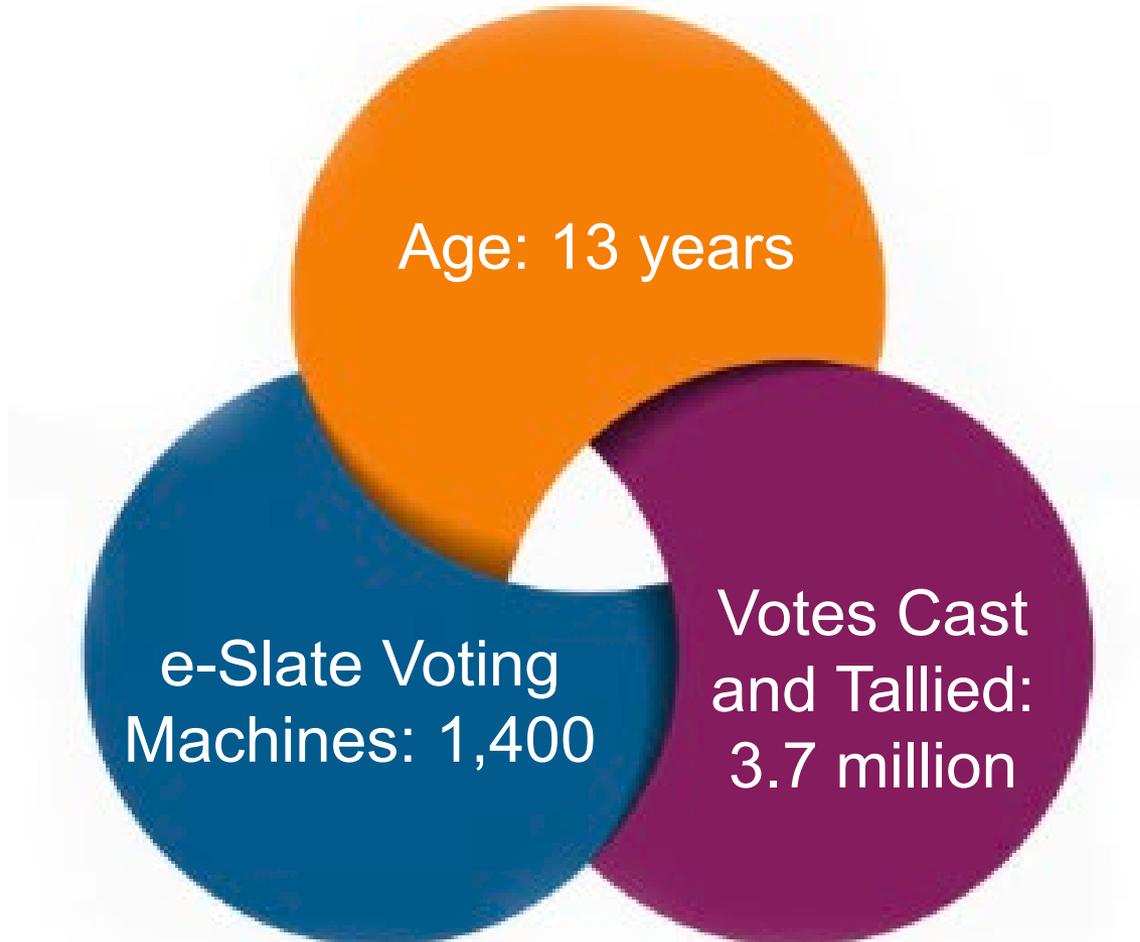

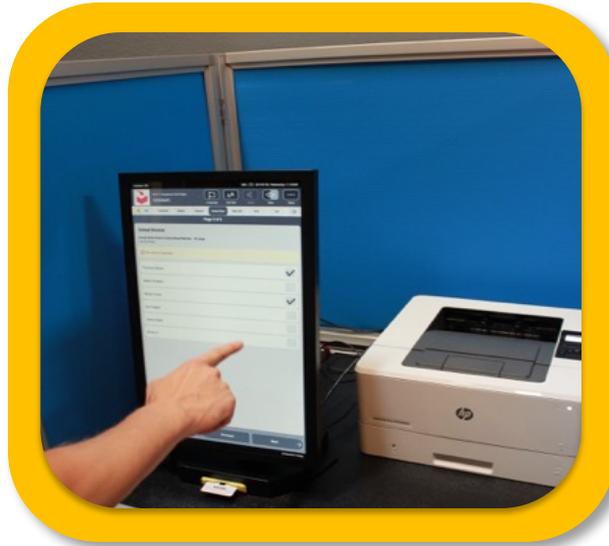

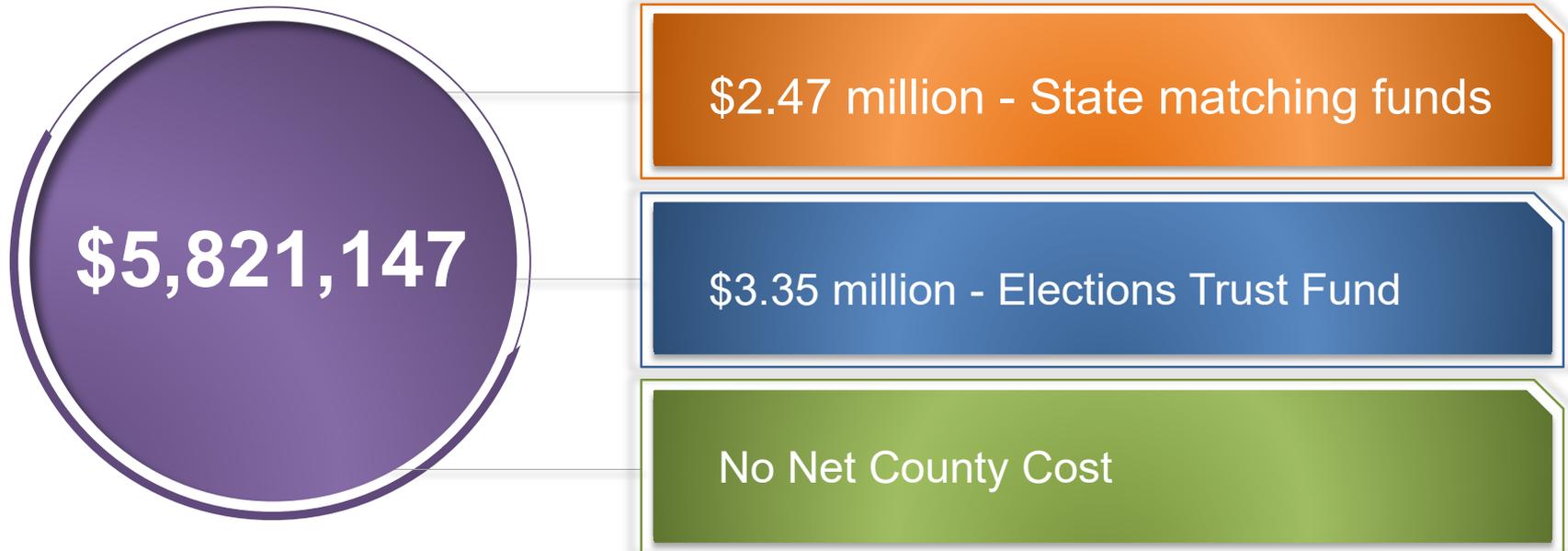
