
#### **DISCUSSION**

The location of the concrete color edge bands and unit pavers will be in the special plazas.


The Committee can discuss and give input to Staff.

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

Staff would like input on the crossing and truncated domes. There are crossings that have the pavers/bricks on one side but not the other side. Staff would like input on if bricks/pavers are desired on both sides or not.

- Crossing to the pathway along the exit drive – may want to leave more natural looking, but will need domes
- Crossing to the North Meadow

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The Valley Oak at the Children's Picnic Area/Day Use are has been reviewed by our contracted Tree Maintenance Company , West Coast Arborist's and is found to be unsafe due to decay fungus, for people to picnic under it. It is recommened to move the picnic area away from the Valley Oak tree. This wil impact the circulation plan as a path and ADA decomposed granite is proposed for this area.

The tree will be sprayed with Phosphonate in Fall or late Winter to help slow down the fungus.

Staff would like input on pathway and picnic area relocation.

I have proposed three locations below. Staff is open to suggestions for other locations.



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
