
SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF DONATION NAMING REQUESTS

Accept various naming requests from specified donors.


BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS




Small Conference Room in Library –
Bob and Connie Lurie (this room may be themed with baseball memorabilia to tie in with the adjacent Willie May’s Room)


Redwood Grove behind the Library –
