RE: TRAFFIC REPORT – January 2022

The following is a summary of the activities that have occurred during the month, as well as a summary of the collision, citation and DUI statistics for the Police Department.

### **TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS**

The Atherton Police Department received no traffic complaints from residents during the month of January.

### **MONTHLY DUI REPORT**

One (1) arrest was made for Driving Under the Influence during the month of January. None of these arrests were the result of a traffic collision.

### **TRUCK ENFORCEMENT DATA**

No Truck Stop Details were performed during the month of January.

### **TRAFFIC OFFICER SCHEDULE**

Sergeant Metzger, Officer Rojas, Officer MacDonald and Reserve Officer Boyle were assigned to the Traffic Division during the month of January. These officers utilized their

police motorcycles and worked traffic enforcement as time and calls for service permitted.

Sergeant Metzger was scheduled for 72 hours and produced 50 combined cites.  
Officer Rojas was scheduled for 72 hours and produced 13 combined cites.  
Officer MacDonald was scheduled for 84 hours and produced 52 combined cites.  
Reserve Officer Boyle was scheduled for 72 hours and produced 10 combined cites.

During the Month of January, the department experienced staffing issues due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. During January, the traffic teams were needed to fill patrol duties and assist with other ancillary duties around the department.

### **TRAFFIC COLLISION DATA**

During the month of January, a total of four (4) traffic collisions occurred in the Town of Atherton. Three (3) of the collisions involved injuries. There were no Hit-and-Run collisions during the period. None of the collisions involved a driver who was driving under the influence.

The collisions occurred in the following locations:

- 1) The intersection of Middlefield Rd and Linden Av.  
Saturday, 10:30am, late report, unable to determine cause of collision.
  
- 2) Green Oaks Dr, 359 south of Oak Grove Av. (Injury)  
Tuesday, 9:20pm, Auto vs. Ped  
Pedestrian: Walking on west shoulder of roadway.  
Vehicle: southbound on northbound side of Greenoaks Av.  
Injuries: Pedestrian transported to Stanford with complain of pain.
  
- 3) El Camino Real / Selby Ln (Non- injury)  
Wednesday, 3:21pm, Failure to Yield to Oncoming Traffic  
Vehicle #1: traveling on Selby Ln turning onto El Camino Real  
Vehicle #2: Southbound El Camino Real
  
- 4) Valparaiso Av / Emilie Av (Injury)  
Friday, 5:03pm, Unsafe Entering of Roadway  
Vehicle #1: Entering Valparaiso Av from the north shoulder of Valparaiso Av  
Vehicle #2: Westbound Valparaiso Av.  
Injuries: Vehicle #2 driver had a complaint of pain and was transported to Stanford

Of the above collisions, none occurred during the morning commute period, 6:00am to 10:00am, Monday through Friday.

Of the above collisions, three (3) occurred during the afternoon commute period, 3:00pm to 7:00pm, Monday through Friday.
